

## Programs Examined


- Permanent Residents/Immigrants (PRs): Economic, Family and Refugees
  - TR to Permanent Resident transition
  - Asylum Claimants by Office Type
- Temporary Residents/International Mobility Program (IMP): International Agreements (e.g., NAFTA, GATS), Canadian Interests (e.g., intra-corporate transfers, work exchange programs, post-graduate employment, spouses)
- Temporary Residents/Temporary Foreign Worker Program (TFWP): caregivers, agriculture workers, other workers with Labour Market Impact Assessment (LMIA)
- Study Permits (international students)
- Citizenship
- Visitor Visas

# June 2020 Highlights


- Immigration continued bounce back compared to May and overall quarter save for TRs
- PRs: From 10,950 in May to 19,180. June Year-over-year decline: Greater gap between Economic only -22.6% compared to Family -69.0%, Refugees -80.2%
  - Provincial Nominee Program: Increase from 2,970 in May to 4,940. June Year-over-year decline smaller than May: -30.9%
  - TR to PRs transition: Increase from 5,820 in May to 12,955. Year-over-year increase of 39.8% (i.e., those already in Canada)
- TRs/IMP: Ongoing decline from 15,700 in May to 13,950. June Year-over-year decline: Agreements -51.0%, Canadian Interests -46.3%
- TRs/TFWP: Stable 9,365 in May compared to 9,200. June Year-over-year decline: Caregivers -64.5%, Agriculture -8.9%, Other LMIA -50.1%
- Students: Decline from 30,785 in May to 16,000. June Year-over-year decrease: 32.8%
- Citizenship: Increase from virtually none in May (53) to 1,656. June Year-over-year decrease: 92.0%.(2019 monthly average was about 20,000)
- Visitor Visas: Complete shutdown. China authorizations declined faster and sharper
- IRCC Website interest (July, Work and study permits, settlement services and citizenship) broadly reflect these trends)


### Admissions: PRs by Categories — 2018-20



### Admissions: PRs Region of Citizenship — 2018-20




# Admissions: Provincial Nominee Program — 2018-20




#### Admissions: PRs Total, Provincial Nominee Program

Year to year comparison (monthly)—2018-20




#### Admissions: PRs Canada Total

Year to Year Comparison by Category—June 2020, Last Quarter




#### Admissions: PNP Provinces

Year-over-year Comparison by Category—June 2020, Last Quarter Top 10 Countries — Ordered by 2018 base year




#### Admissions: Permanent Residents by Citizenship

Year to Year Comparison (June 2020, Last Quarter) Top 10 Countries — Ordered by 2018 base year




### Admissions: Temporary to Permanent Residents

By Program—2018-20





Year-over-year Comparison by Province—June 2020, Last Quarter Top 10 Countries — Ordered by 2018 base year



Year to Year Comparison by Program — June 2020, Last quarter




### Asylum Claimants: Office Type




### Asylum Claimants: Office Type Year-over-year

Comparison by Category—June 2020, Last Quarter




### Asylum Claimants: Year-over-year

Top 10 Countries—Ordered by 2018 base year—June 2020, Last Quarter




#### IMP & TFWP Work Permit Holders—2018-20



### IMP by Region of Citizenship—2018-20




### TFWP by Region of Citizenship—2018-20




#### IMP & TFWP Work Permit Holders Total

Year to Year Comparison (Monthly)




### Temporary Residents by Program Canada

Year to Year Comparison by Category—June 2020, Last Quarter




#### IMP by Citizenship

Top 10 Countries—Ordered by 2018 base year




#### TFWP by Citizenship

Top 10 Countries—Ordered by 2018 base year




#### Work Permits—Web Interest Year to Year Comparison (July 2020, Last Quarter)

Top 10 Countries by "Get a work permit" ordered by site visits, 2018 base year



### Study Permit Holders—By Level—2018-20




### Study Permit Holders—By Region—2018-20




#### Study Permit Holders by Citizenship

Top 10 Countries — Ordered by Number of Permits, 2018 base year




### Study Permit Holders

Year-over-year Comparison by Province—June 2020, Last Quarter




#### Study Permits—Web Interest Year-over-year Comparison (July 2020, Last Quarter)

Top 10 Countries by "Get your study permit" ordered by site visits, 2018 base year






#### Settlement Services—Web Interest Year-over-year Comparison (July 2020, Last Quarter)

Top 10 Countries by "Find immigrant services near you" ordered by site visits, 2018 base year





#### New Citizens—By Region of Birth—2018-20




#### Citizenship by Region of Birth

Top 10 Countries—Ordered by 2018 base year






# Citizenship – Web Interest 2020 to 2018 Comparison (July 2020, Last Quarter)

Top 10 Countries by "Get your study permit" ordered by site visits, 2018 base year




