

Programs Examined


- Permanent Residents/Immigrants (PRs): Economic, Family and Refugees
- Temporary Residents/International Mobility Program (IMP): International Agreements (e.g., NAFTA, GATS), Canadian Interests (e.g., intra-corporate transfers, work exchange programs, post-graduate employment, spouses)
- Temporary Residents/Temporary Foreign Worker Program (TFWP): caregivers, agriculture workers, other workers with Labour Market Impact Assessment (LMIA)
- Study Permits (international students)

May 2020 Highlights


- Immigration slightly bounced back compared to April save for TRs
- PRs: From 4,140 in April to 10,950. May year-to-year decline: Economic -61.9%, Family -76.6%, Refugees -72.0%
 - Provincial Nominee Program: From 1,295 in April to 2,970. May year-to-year decline: -50.2%
- TRs/IMP: Slght decline from 16,695 in April to 15,700. May year-to-year decline: Agreements -53.6%, Canadian Interests -43.3%
- TRs/TFWP: Decline 13,335 in April to 9,365. May year-to-year decline: Caregivers -70.1%, Agriculture -3.6%, Other LMIA -41.1%
- Students: From 19,040 in April to 30,785. May year-to-year increase: 10.7 percent


Admissions: PRs by Categories - 2018-20



Admissions: PRs by Region of Citizenship—2018-20




Admissions: Provincial Nominee Program




Admissions PRs Canada Total

Year to Year Comparison (monthly)







Year to Year Comparison by Category—Last Quarter, May 2020




Admissions PNP Provinces

Year to Year Comparison by Category—Last Quarter, May 2020




Admissions by Citizenship

Year to Year Comparison (May 2020, Last Quarter) Top 10 Countries — Ordered by 2018 base year




IMP & TFWP Work Permit Holders



IMP by Region of Citizenship—2018-20




TFWP by Region of Citizenship—2018-20




IMP & TFWP Work Permit Holders Total

Year to Year Comparison (Monthly)




Temporary Residents by Program Canada

Year to Year Comparison by Category—Last Quarter, May 2020




IMP by Citizenship

Year to Year Comparison (May 2020, Last Quarter) Top 10 Countries — Ordered by 2018 base year




TFWP by Citizenship

Year to Year Comparison (May 2020, Last Quarter) Top 10 Countries — Ordered by 2018 base year



Study Permit Holders—By Level




Study Permit Holders—By Region





Year to Year Comparison by Province—Last Quarter, May 2020




Study Permit Holders by Citizenship
