

## Programs Examined

- Permanent Residents/Immigrants (PRs): Economic, Family and Refugees
  - TR to Permanent Resident transition
  - Asylum Claimants by Office Type
- Temporary Residents/International Mobility Program (IMP): International Agreements (e.g., NAFTA, GATS), Canadian Interests (e.g., intra-corporate transfers, work exchange programs, post-graduate employment, spouses)
- Temporary Residents/Temporary Foreign Worker Program (TFWP): caregivers, agriculture workers, other workers with Labour Market Impact Assessment (LMIA)
- Study Permits (international students)
- Asylum Claimants
- Citizenship
- Visitor Visas


## November 2020 Highlights

- November immigration numbers largely flat compared to October, permanent, temporary and students, with decline in applications
- PRs: Admissions remained largely flat, from 15,070 in October to 15,270 in November. November Year-over-year decline: Economic 48.9%, Family 40.3%. Refugees increase of 9.3%
  - Applications: Decrease from 17,160 in September to 15,468 in October. October year-over-year decrease 52.4%
  - Provincial Nominee Program: Flat, from 2,920 in October to 2,835 in November . October year-over-year decrease: 40%
  - TR to PRs transition (i.e., those already in Canada): Increase from 6,395 in October to 7,195 in November (some double counting). November Year-over-year increase of 2.2%, driven by Post-graduate work program increase of 19.5%

#### • Temporary Residents:


- TRs/IMP: Flat, from 34,815 in October (60% post-grad employment) to 33,875 in November. November Year-over-year change: Agreements decrease of 13.6%, Canadian Interests increase of 55.5%
- TRs/TFWP: Increase from 4,815 in October to 5,300 in November. November year-over-year decline: Caregivers 23.9% and Other LMIA 12.9%. Agriculture Increase of 19.9%,
  - Web "Get a work permit": From 56,923 in November to 51,674 in December (outside Canada). December Year-over-year decline: 25.1%
- Students: Flat, 15,050 in October to 15,000 in November. November year-over-year increase of 19.2%, likely reflecting COVID delays
  - Applications: Decrease (seasonal) from 27,141 in September to 21,728 in October. October Year-over-year decrease: 30%
  - Web "Get a study permit": From 54,735 in November (outside Canada) to 51,556 in December. December Year-over-year decrease: 12.5%
- Asylum Claimants: Flat, from 1,310 in October to 1,320 in November (about 75% inland). November year-over-year decrease: 75.4%
- Settlement Services (May): Decline from 112,380 in April to 101,415 in May. Year-over-year decrease 9.8 percent
  - Web "Find immigrant services hear you": From 10,601 in November (outside Canada) to 8,333 in December. December Year-over-year decrease: 41%
- Citizenship: Decrease from 13,766 in September to 8,598 in October. October Year-over-year decrease: 56.3%.
  - Web "Apply for citizenship": From 32,027 in November (outside Canada) to 22,051 in December. December 2020-2018 decrease: 5.6%%
- Visitor Visas: Slight increase from earlier complete shutdown. From 4,184 in September to 6,229 in October. October Year-over-year decrease: 91.3%

# Overall Decline Across all Programs April-November 2019-20 Comparison




### PR Applications: Region of Citizenship —2018-20




## Admissions: PRs by Categories — 2018-20



### Admissions: PRs Region of Citizenship — 2018-20




# Admissions: Provincial Nominee Program — 2018-20




### Admissions: PRs Total, Provincial Nominee Program

Year to year comparison (monthly)—2019-20




### Admissions: PRs Canada Total

Year-to-Year Comparison by Category — November 2020, Quarterly




### Admissions: PNP Provinces

Year-over-year Comparison - November 2020, Year-to-date




### Admissions: Permanent Residents by Citizenship

Top 10 Countries — Ordered by 2018 base year




### Admissions: Temporary to Permanent Residents

By Program—2018-20




### Admissions by Program: TRs to PRs

Year-over-year Comparison by Province-November 2020, Year-to-date




### Admissions: TRs to PRs

Year to Year Comparison by Program – November 2020, Year-to-date




## Asylum Claimants: Office Type 2018-20




## Asylum Claimants: Year-over-year

Comparison by Office Type-November 2020, Quarterly




### Asylum Claimants: Year-over-year

Top 10 Countries — Ordered by 2018 base year — November 2020, Last Quarter




### IMP & TFWP Work Permit Holders—2018-20



## IMP by Region of Citizenship—2018-20




## TFWP by Region of Citizenship—2018-20




### IMP & TFWP Work Permit Holders Total

Year to Year Comparison (Monthly)





Year to Year Comparison by Category-November 2020, Quarterly





Top 10 Countries—Ordered by 2018 base year




#### TFWP by Citizenship

Top 10 Countries—Ordered by 2018 base year




#### Work Permits—Web Interest Year to Year Comparison (December 2020, Year-to-date)

Top 10 Countries by "Get a work permit" ordered by site visits, 2018 base year




### Study Permit Applications—By Region—2018-20




### Study Permit Holders by Citizenship

Top 10 Countries — Ordered by Number of Permits, 2018 base year



Year-over-year Comparison by Province-November 2020, Quarterly




#### Study Permits—Web Interest Year-over-year Comparison (December 2020, Year-to-date)

Top 10 Countries by "Get your study permit" ordered by site visits, 2018 base year







Year-over-year Comparison by Province – May 2020, Last Quarter




#### Settlement Services by Citizenship

Top 10 Non-EU Not USA—Ordered by Number of PRs, 2018 base year




#### Settlement Services — Web Interest Year-over-year Comparison (December 2020, Year-to-date)

Top 10 Countries by "Find immigrant services near you" ordered by site visits, 2018 base year





### New Citizens—By Region of Birth—2018-20




#### Citizenship by Region of Birth

Top 10 Countries—Ordered by 2018 base year






# Citizenship — Web Interest 2020 to 2018 Comparison (December 2020, Year-to-date)

Top 10 Countries by "Apply for Citizenship" ordered by site visits, 2018 base year




