

# Programs Examined

- Permanent Residents/Immigrants (PRs): Economic, Family and Refugees
  - TR to Permanent Resident transition
  - Asylum Claimants
- Temporary Residents/International Mobility Program (IMP): International Agreements (e.g., NAFTA, GATS),
  Canadian Interests (e.g., intra-corporate transfers, work exchange programs, post-graduate employment,
  spouses)
- Temporary Residents/Temporary Foreign Worker Program (TFWP): caregivers, agriculture workers, other workers with Labour Market Impact Assessment (LMIA)
- Study Permits (international students)
- Settlement Services
- Citizenship
- Visitor Visas


# March 2021 Highlights

- March immigration continued to come back closer to traditional levels, reflecting government decision to use inventory of temporary residents to transition to permanent residency: First quarter 70,425 permanent resident admissions, annualized would be about 280,000
- PRs: Admissions decreased slightly from 23,365 in February to 22,410 in March. March Year-over-year change (change from 2019 in parentheses): Economic 29.3% (-10.2%), Family -25.4% (-42.7%), Refugees 53.1% (-5.7%)
  - Applications: Increase from 22,516 in February to 24,195 in March. March year-over-year change (change from 2019): -17.9% (-30.4%)
  - Web "Immigrate to Canada": Largely flat, from 360,525 in March (outside Canada) to 362,518 in April. April year-over-year change (change from 2019): 32.6% (2.0)%
  - Provincial Nominee Program: Decrease from 6,355 in January to 4,565 in February. February year-over-year change (change from 2019): -5.6% (-50.4%)
  - TR to PRs transition (i.e., those already in Canada): Increase from 11,680 in February (some double counting) to 12,625 in March. March year-over-year change (change from 2019): 138.4% (43.2%)

#### Temporary Residents:


- TRs/IMP: Flat, from 30,885 in February (post-grad employment 37%) to 31,115 in March. March year-over-year increase (two year change): Agreements 60.5% (-9.1%), Canadian Interests: 131.8% (72.8%). Other IMP Participants (largely open work permits granted to Hong Kong residents who hold HSAR or BNO passports) 11,756%
- TRs/TFWP: Increase from 9,120 in February to 14,125 in March. March year-over-year increase (two year change): Caregivers 202.5% (-5.5%), Agriculture 174.3% (50.5%) and Other LMIA 114.8% (112.9%).
  - Web "Get a work permit": From 59,929 in March (outside Canada) to 54,203 in April. April year-over-year change (change from 2019): -7.9% (-26.9%)
- Students: Increase from 18,930 in February to 22,790 in March. March year-over-year change (change from 2019): 104.8% (13.3%)
  - Applications: Decline from 47,835 in February (revised) to 44,073 in March. March year-over-year change (change from 2019): 136.7% (107.5%)
  - Web "Get a study permit": From 77,401 in March (outside Canada) to 92,843 in April. Year-over-year change (change from 2019): 112.8% (21.5%)
- Asylum Claimants: Increase from 1,080 in February (about 75% inland) to 1,280 in March. March year-over-year change (change from 2019): -64.2% (-69.7%)
- Settlement Services (December): Decline from 48,700 in November to 42,890 in December. December year-over-year (change from 2019): 21.6% (-17.1%)
  - Web "Find immigrant services hear you": From 9,513 in March (outside Canada) to 8,608 in April. April year-over-year change (change from 2019): 23.3% (-22.5)
- Citizenship: Decrease from 3,631 in February to 2,561 in March. March year-over-year change (change from 2019): -72.9% (-88.4%)
  - Applications: From 16,783 in February to 6,069 in March. March year-over-year change (change from 2019): -70.4% (-76.1%)
  - "Apply for citizenship": From 20,451 in March (outside Canada) to 19,161 in April. April year-over-year change (change from 2019): -16.3% (9.0%)
- Visitor Visas: Decrease from 5,208 in February to 4,431 in March. March year-over-year change (change from 2019): -89.1% (-94.9%)

# Overall Decline Across all Programs April-December 2019-20 Comparison




#### PR Applications: Region of Citizenship —2018-21




### Admissions: PRs by Categories — 2018-21



#### Admissions: PRs Region of Citizenship — 2018-21




# Admissions: Provincial Nominee Program — 2018-21




#### Admissions: PRs Total, Provincial Nominee Program

Two-Year Comparison (monthly)




# Admissions: PRs Canada Total March Comparison: 2021/20, 2021/19




#### Admissions: PNP Provinces

Comparison — March: 2021/20, 2021/19




#### Admissions: Permanent Residents by Citizenship

March Comparison: 2021/20, 2021/19 Top 10 Countries — Ordered by 2018 base year




#### Admissions: Temporary to Permanent Residents

By Program — 2018-21




### Admissions by Program: TRs to PRs




#### Admissions: TRs to PRs




## Asylum Claimants: Office Type 2018-21




### Asylum Claimants: Year-over-year










#### IMP & TFWP Work Permit Holders—2018-21



## IMP by Region of Citizenship—2018-21




## TFWP by Region of Citizenship—2018-21




#### IMP & TFWP Work Permit Holders Total

Year to Year Comparison (Monthly)







Top 10 Countries—Ordered by 2018 base year




#### TFWP by Citizenship

March Comparison: 2021/20, 2021/19 Top 10 Countries—Ordered by 2018 base year




#### Work Permits—Web Interest April Comparison—2021/20, 2021/19

Top 10 Countries by "Get a work permit" ordered by site visits, 2018 base year




#### Study Permit Applications—By Region—2018-21



#### Study Permit Holders—By Level—2018-21




#### Study Permit Holders by Citizenship

Top 10 Countries — Ordered by Number of Permits, 2018 base year




# Study Permit Holders by Province






## Settlement—By Service—2018-20

In Canada Services—Top 25 Countries





Year-over-year Comparison by Service - December 2020, Last Quarter





Year-over-year Comparison by Province - December 2020, Last Quarter




#### Settlement Services by Citizenship

Year-over-year Comparison — December 2020, Last Quarter Top 10, 2018 base year




# Settlement Services—Web Interest Comparison—April 2021/20, April 2021/19

Top 10 Countries by "Find immigrant services near you" ordered by site visits, 2018 base year






### New Citizens—By Region of Birth—2018-21




#### Citizenship by Region of Birth

March Comparison: 2021/20, 2021/19 Top 10 Countries—Ordered by 2018 base year






